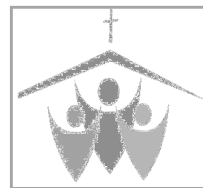

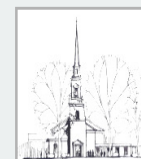

Harrison UM Youth Fundraiser at Matthews Township Grille Tuesday, June 8, from 6-9 p.m.

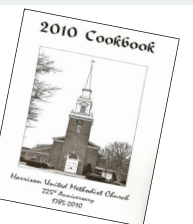
