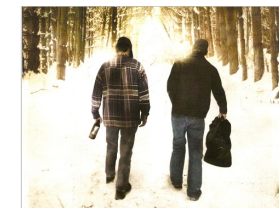
"Planner for Life & Death Emergencies" Booklet
