# MISSION: BELIZE

## Cost

---

\$910 per person + Airfare

The \$910 covers housing, meals, construction and programming. It does not cover travel to Belize or the costs of meals while traveling.

A deposit of \$150 is required in order to sign up. The deadline is February 16. No refund after this date.

Airfare is estimated between \$900 - \$1000.

This brings the total cost of the trip to \$1810 - \$1910. Work Projects

## Fundraising

---

Our main fundraising will be a silent auction to be held in the early Spring. Each participant will be required to acquire 5 items for the silent auction. We hope to decrease the cost by \$1000 per person with this fundraiser.

You may also raise money by asking friends and relatives to sponsor you. You may use letter, social media or other methods.

## Accommodations

---

We will be housed and working with King's Children's Home in the village of Cotton Tree. Sleeping will be on twin beds, and we encourage everyone to bring bedding they would consider donating to the Children's Home. The King's Home will provide meals that will be a combination of Belizean and American food.

## Work Projects

---

We will have projects in the mornings doing some type of construction and possibly working in the community gardens. In the afternoons, we will have our children's ministry program known as 'SGO (Summer's Greatest Outreach). There will be an organized program, where we spend time with the kids, reading, playing and tutoring.

## Evening Program

---

Each evening of the trip, everyone gathers together to fellowship, sing, worship, pray, and receive a message brought from God's Word by the evening speaker.

## Work Groups

---

All participants will be assigned work groups. Work groups are made up of people from all of the church groups at the camp. Everyone will have at least one person from their church group with them, but this is also a great time to meet new people!

# What You Need Before The Trip

## Passport

You will want to get this early. Make an appointment to get your passport at a Passport Acceptance Facility. You may find the closest one to you by going to <https://iafdb.travel.state.gov>.



Please see separate sheet for information on obtaining a passport for someone under the age of 18.

Cost for age 16 and up is \$145. For below the age of 16 cost is \$115.

## Shots / Medication



Make sure your youth is up to date on all routine vaccinations. These vaccines include measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine, diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis vaccine, varicella (chickenpox) vaccine, polio vaccine, and your yearly flu shot.

It is also recommended that you get a Hepatitis A and Typhoid vaccine.

## Meetings

There will be a few meetings before the trip that each participant must attend. These meetings will range from planning and organizing the silent auction to learning about Belize. The meetings will also be a way for us to prepare spiritually for the mission trip.



## Prayer



Right now we are the only group registered for the Belize trip with Son Servants. They require at least 25 participants for the trip to happen, so we need you to pray that more churches sign up to go.
